

## 2024 Girl Scout Scholarship Recommendation Form

Through an application process, Girl Scouts of Northern Illinois (GSNI) awards scholarships each year to qualifying GSNI members. To qualify for a GSNI scholarship, a Girl Scout must be graduating from high school, plan to go on to further education, demonstrate an understanding of Girl Scout values, currently live by the values expressed in the Girl Scout Promise and Law, and must be actively involved in Girl Scouting during their high school years.

This recommendation form is to be completed by one adult Girl Scout Member **and** one <u>unrelated</u> adult who can attest to the criteria listed below. NO family member references are accepted. To maintain consistency among all applicants, only this recommendation form will be accepted.

This is a confidential form that will be viewed by the GSNI Scholarship Committee and GSNI staff overseeing the scholarship process. This information will not be shared with the Girl Scout who has requested your reference.

This form may be completed electronically and submitted via email using the following naming convention: **Recommendation for** *Girl Scout's First name Last name*, or it can be printed out and mailed.
