Minors under the age of 18 traveling out of their home state, within the United States, when not accompanied on the trip by parent(s), must have an affidavit from the parent(s) not accompanying the child that:

- 1. The child is traveling out of their home state, within United States, with the permission of the parent(s).
- 2. That the non-traveling parent(s) is aware that the child is leaving on the departure date, and
- 3. The name(s) of the person(s) accompanying the child.
