We all love giving and receiving bouquets.

Spring is just around the corner and **Whispering Willow** flower shop is involved with **Flowers For Kids**. This is an educational program that is designed to teach scouts of all ages about how to grow, take care of, and enjoy flowers. The class encompasses a little bit of biology, chemistry, and artistry.

Each interactive class lasts about forty-five minutes and can accommodate up to fifty scouts. At no cost to you, I can come to your desired location, set up, go through my program and help the girls create a bouquet. By the end of the class all involved know how to treat flowers, make flower food, and do a basic flower arrangement with fillers, lines, focals and greens.
