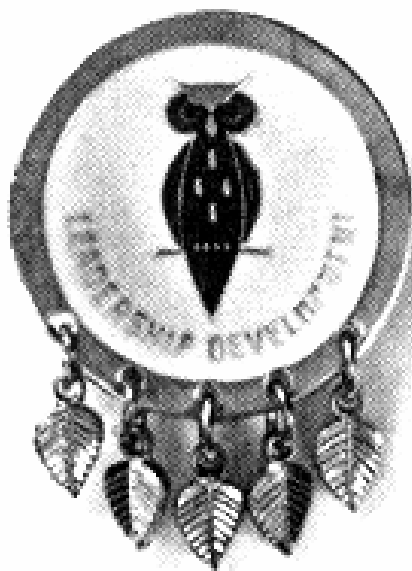

<p>Leadership Development Pin</p> 	<p>For troop/group leader, assistant leader, or coordinator</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a registered Girl Scout adult • Have completed one successful year in the position of troop/group leader, assistant leader, or group coordinator • Have completed the appropriate training and have demonstrated position competence • Actively recognize, understand, and practice the values of inclusive behavior 	<p>The candidate submits an application which is reviewed by the Volunteer Development Specialist. If all requirements have been met, the recognition is authorized.</p>
<p><i>Additional Recognition:</i> Green Leaf Silver Leaf Gold Leaf</p>	<p>For Prior Leadership Development Pin Recipients</p>	<p>Green Leaf: Represents 10 contact hours or one CEU of additional training</p> <p>Silver Leaf: Represents 50 contact hours or five CEUs of additional training</p> <p>Gold Leaf: Represents 250 contact hours or 25 CEUs of additional training</p>	<p>Candidates applying for leaves need to document their hours and describe how the workshop/course has improved their work with girls.</p>
