I commit to:

- Attend one or more meetings to assist with the girls
- Be the troop/group bookkeeper and maintain the finances
- Be the troop/group fall product chair
- Be the troop/group Girl Scout cookie chair
- Assist with a flag ceremony and court of awards
- Help the girls find and set up suitable ways to give community service
- Research and help plan field trips (with the advice of the girls)
- Chaperone one or more field trips or overnights

- Help the leadership team comprise the troop/group newsletter to parents
- Help the girls plan an overnight or camping trip
- Be a certified first-aider for the troop/group for field trips
- Be a certified life guard for the troop/group
