

## Procedures for Other Pathways Participating in the Girl Scout Cookie Program

1. All Pathway Girl Scouts are encouraged to participate in the Girl Scout Cookie Program. The Service Unit Cookie Coordinator, or other designated contact person, will distribute materials to each Girl Scout in every Pathway in the service unit.
2. All non-troop Girl Scouts participating in the Cookie Program will contact the Service Unit Cookie Coordinator, or other designated contact person, for entry of their order(s). They will utilize the same procedure as those used by other troops/groups in the service unit. Their orders will be entered online by first and last name using a council-assigned number for their orders(s).
3. All non-troop Girl Scout Pathways must turn in or deposit the total sales amount collected. The Service Unit Cookie Coordinator, or other designated contact person, will accept the entire amount to deposit into a service unit checking account or to take to the nearest service center.
4. Each participating girl will receive "S'More Dough" vouchers in increments of \$10.00. We always round up to the next increment for their proceeds.
5. If girls are participating in a Series at the time of the sale and specify the need for funds, the adult in charge of the Series must contact her local service center Product Sales Manager to review the request.
6. Girls may apply the "S'More Dough" to their fees for resident camps, day/twilight camps, any council and service unit events, *destinations*, or Girl Scouts of the USA \$12 registration. The vouchers may also be spent in any Council Shop or at Girl Scout Express.
7. For girls working on their Girl Scout Silver or Gold Award projects, we will redeem to the nearest dollar the price of any item purchased for the completion of their project provided the proper receipts accompany the request.
8. "S'More Dough" vouchers have an expiration date of the last date of business in September. This expiration date may be extended for girls saving toward a *destination*, a planned trip, or a Lifetime Membership to Girl Scouts of the USA. Please stress that in order for this extension to be approved, they must turn in the "S'More Dough" voucher to any service center by the original expiration date.
9. Girl Scouts of Northern Illinois will not replace lost or expired vouchers.
10. "S'More Dough" vouchers are not transferrable.
