



## WHAT'S NEW WITH COOKIE BOOTHS IN 2012?

***Sign up in eBudde for your Cookie Booth again this year!***

**Product Program Staff will contact large chain grocery and discount stores and input time slots into eBudde. Some examples of these stores are:**

Jewel, Dominick's, Walgreens, Joseph's, Lowe's, Sam's Club, Costco and Culver's

**NOTE:** *Lowe's will allow only troops with girls who do not have Lowe's employees in their families.*

**Troops will contact all other businesses such as:**

**Walmart**, banks, churches, restaurants, retail shops, book stores, gas stations (girls may be inside only), etc., and input them into eBudde. Confirmation of approval or denial of these submissions will be e-mailed to the troop.

**NOTE:** *In order to more effectively coordinate Cookie Booth scheduling at Walmart locations, this year troops will be directly contacting their local Walmart stores to secure permission for a Cookie Booth. Please be advised that some Walmart locations require that requests be submitted to them two to three weeks in advance of the desired date. Check with your Walmart early to find out their requirements.*

**Businesses with a No-Solicitation policy are:**

Aldi, Costco, The Fresh Market, Home Depot, Meijer, and Target

**Initial eBudde Booth Signup:** **January 9, 2012** (6:00 A.M.) – **January 14, 2012** (11:59 P.M.)

**Rules for Initial Signup:**

- (1) Three (3) choices of dates and times.
- (2) Each choice must be a different business.
- (3) eBudde will determine booth allocation.

**Secondary eBudde Booth Signup:** **January 15, 2012** (6:00 A.M.) – **March 18, 2012** (11:59 P.M.)

**Rule for Secondary Signup:** Unlimited choices of dates, times and ten locations.
