Natural Resource Programs Upon Request

The Winnebago County Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) provides educational programs. Experienced staff travels to your location and provides programs throughout the year. Program topics may include rain barrels, rain gardens, groundwater, watersheds, aquatics, soils, forestry, wildlife, recycling, composting, prairies and the Illinois State Symbols. Most programs and topics are geared towards children in late elementary and middle school. We will work with you to provide you exactly what you are looking for in an educational program.

The SWCD requests a fee of \$2.00 per participant for a single program lasting no more than three hours. For programs involving combined groups/classes, the fee is \$1.00/participant. The SWCD may have the final say on payment per participant depending on the amount of materials needed for the program. Programs may be conducted indoors or out, depending on the season and topic.
