

C3 Leadership Committee Position Description

Purpose:

The C3 Leadership Committee will give girls a “voice” in council activities and decisions. Girls selected for this committee will serve as advocates for all girls 5-17 years old. As a member of this committee, a girl will be serving in a leadership capacity to help ensure the quality of Girl Scouting in Girl Scouts of Northern Illinois (GSNI).

Term: One year (May, however, be elected for an additional term as agreed.)

Elected by: Service Unit (Each Service Unit may elect two girls).

Requirements:

- Register as member of GSUSA and be at least 14 years old
- Attend position retreat at Camp McCormick (Stillman Valley) – **Mandatory!**
- Attend the council wide Annual Meeting
- Serve on one additional GSNI committee
- Available to attend council wide meeting(s) to represent girls
- Attend additional C3 meetings to be scheduled at a later date
- Available by email
- Comfortable speaking in a group
- Believe you can make the world a better place

Responsibilities:

- Be an example to others by living the Promise and Law
- Provide input on issues relevant to today’s girls by joining other GSNI Committees
- Participate in elections and other responsibilities at the Annual Meeting
- Help create and implement events for Girl Scouts, Cadettes through Ambassador
- Attend Leader meetings at least once a year to promote C3 activities
- Promote a positive image of Girl Scouting throughout the community
- Help make the world a better place
