# Session Descriptions

**Ceremonies**—(Laurie Cwerenz) Opening, closing, flag, bridging, special recognition . . . create your own! Learn how to add a special flair to your meetings with a ceremony.

**Dutch Oven Cooking**—(Lesley Tennesen) Learn a new skill or get a new recipe with Dutch Oven Cooking. You will learn heat control, methods, cleaning and care of cast iron, tips and tricks. And best of all, you get to eat the rewards of your cooking efforts. Come hungry! **Cost: \$10**

**Field Trip Basics**—(Chris Peddle) This course will prepare you to take your girls on field trips. It includes using *Safety-Wise*, progression, safety and security guidelines, Girl Scout standards, activity checkpoints, planning trips, seat belt law for children under the age of 8, health history forms, first aiders, incident reports, and Girl Scout insurance.

**Girl Scout Trivia**—(Sue Reimer) Learn more about Girl Scout history and GS Trivia!

**Internet Resources**—(Laurie Cwerenz) This class will delve into the different internet resources available to you and your girls for planning and executing the Girl Scout program.

**Journeys**—(Georgianne Chromczak) This workshop offers some practical advice on using Journeys at your troop meeting. Find out how badges, field trips, speakers, awards, ceremonies, and service projects all work together with your troop's Journey.

**Leadership Essentials**—(Chris Peddle) This learning opportunity is for new and existing volunteers and takes the place of previous program level training . Once you have taken this course, you will NOT need any further program level training. This course will help you understand the meaning of the three keys to the Girl Scout Leadership Experience. It will demonstrate how to use resources to support the delivery of the Girl Scout Leadership Experience, including the journeys (Girls' book with accompanying Guide for Adult Volunteers).

**Older-Girl Crafts**—(Georgainne Chromczak) Get your older girls interested in crafting again with "green" crafts. Learn the how-to's of recycling a tank-top into a tote bag and recycling a computer keyboard's keys in a bracelet, along with receiving instruction on several other "green" crafts that can spark an older girl's imagination and help our environment too. **For this class, you will need to bring a tank top (no spaghetti straps!).**

**Planning Trips for Older Girls**—(Laurie Cwerenz) This class will advise you on how to help your older girls plan outings and trips under Girl Scouts of Northern Illinois procedures and guidelines.

**Girl Scout Bronze, Silver & Gold Award Take-Action Learning Module**—(Lee Holmes) Learn how to help girls raise the bar to Take Action and make a difference in their communities through earning Girl Scouts highest awards. Participants should download the age-appropriate summer 2009 guidelines from the GSNI website, or available for purchase at the session. These include all the girl and adult guidelines. **(GS Bronze - \$2) (GS Silver - \$3) (GS Gold - \$4.50)**

**Simple Cooking/Fire Safety**—(Mary Chris Arnesen) Learn the basics of fire building and safety, and simple recipes for beginning cooks. **Cost: \$3 (Optional cookbook is \$5 additional)**

**Soap Making**—(Sue Reimer) Learn hands-on basic soap making skills to share with your girls.

**Songs & Games**—(Mary Chris Arnesen) Fun games and songs that you can use to add excitement to troop meetings and campouts.

**Team Building**—(Lynda Blacker) Team building skills are essential to leadership development. Playing games and doing activities as a team encourages cooperative learning, which shows girl how to work through challenges and resolve conflicts as a group. Come play with us and learn how to encourage and help your girls identify their individual and team strengths.

**What's WAGGS?**—(Sue Reimer) Learn about international Girl Scouts, Girl Guides, and the four World Centers.
