Let's have the best year ever! The Juliette Star guidelines provide you—Juliette Girl Scout and adult Juliette Helper—with a roadmap for your Girl Scout year. Following this roadmap will lead to an exceptional experience and will set you up for success. Or, in other words, you'll have the best year ever! To qualify for Juliette Star designation, you must complete 12 *required* elements and (because Girl Scouts is all about customizing your experience) 3 *your choice* elements.

Timing

The Juliette Star Program spans the membership year (October 2020 through September 2021).

Patches

All Juliette Girl Scouts and adult Juliette Helpers earning Juliette Star for the first time may purchase the Juliette Star patch. After the first year, girls and adults purchase only the year bar.

This is a council program and patches/bars should be worn on the back of the vest or sash.

You may purchase your patches at the time you turn in your completed Juliette Star Tracking Forms. This program is "On Your Honor," which means you are immediately eligible to purchase patches.

Forms

Completed forms may be submitted to any of GSNI's Resource Centers **between June 15, 2021 and October 15, 2021**. When you're all finished, you have two options for submitting your forms and purchasing your patches:

Option 1: Visit a Resource Center. Visit any one of GSNI's Resource Centers to submit your paperwork in-person, at which time the appropriate patches and/or year bars may be purchased.

Option 2: Via Email. Email the completed Juliette Star Program Forms to customercare@girlscoutsnri.org with **SUBJECT LINE: Juliette Star 2021**. Indicate in the email that you'd like to order/ship (shipping fees apply) your patches. Once the email is received, you will be contacted by phone for payment information.



ADULT ASSISTANCE

Required Elements: Complete all 3!



Adult Registration: Adult helper should register to participate alongside their girl and register as an adult Juliette Helper.



Adult Training: Adult Juliette Helper should complete 415 Juliette Helper learning path in gsLearn. gsLearn can be accessed by logging into myGS.



Safety Activity Checkpoints: Adult Juliette Helper made use of Safety Activity Checkpoints and discussed safety/emergency rules with their Juliette Girl Scout for activities, field trips and overnights.
NOTE: Safety Activity Checkpoints are found in the VTK.

ADULT ASSISTANCE

Your Choice Elements: Complete at least 1!



Service Unit Meetings: Adult helper has attended at least 3 of the service unit meetings during the membership year. (To find out when your Service Unit meetings are, email customercare@girlscoutsni.org.)



Early Renewal: Juliette Girl Scout and adult helper are renewed for the 2022 Membership Year by June 15, 2021.

Promise & Law: Juliette Girl Scout is able to recite the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

Girl Led: Juliette Girl Scout took an active and grade-appropriate role in figuring out the what, where, when, why and how of plans.

Community Service/Take Action: The Juliette Girl Scout participated in at least one community service and/or Take Action project(s).

NOTE: It is recommended that service projects be those where girls are physically doing or making something for someone in the community. Girl Scouts may NOT raise money for other groups which includes activities such as ringing bells for The Salvation Army. Service Projects may include participation in one of the Girl Scout National Service Projects.
