Register as a Girl Scout Volunteer:

□ Visit the Homepage (mygs.girlscouts.org). Create a Household Account: Click Login. In the Login window, navigate to "Don't have an Account" to begin the registration process and choose the troop leadership volunteer role you will be filling.

Complete Criminal Background Check: (valid for three years)

□ You will receive an email link from Asurint to complete an online criminal background check. The link is active for 48 hours. If you missed the timeframe, notify your Recruitment Specialist.

□ You have the option to pay the fee yourself or to have the council pay using (Code: councilpay).

Getting Started Email:

□ Once you have registered into your volunteer role, you will receive a *Welcome to Volunteering with Girl Scouts of Northern Illinois* email with instructions on how to access our learning platform, gsLearn.

□ The Volunteer Development Managers will email your assigned training once your background check has been approved.

Complete the 415 Learn the Basics Training Path:

□ This Training Path must be completed within two weeks of your volunteer role being assigned. If you are specializing in a specific Troop Volunteer Role such as First Aider, Troop Camp Volunteer, Troop Bank Signer; see your training email for additional required trainings to be completed.

□ The Volunteer Development Managers will introduce you to your Member Support Specialist. Your Member Support Specialist will email you with your area's service unit information and local resources!
