<u>One Week From Check-In:</u> Please call the Ranger to confirm your reservation and to receive any other information. **Ranger's phone number is 630-417-0426.** <u>This is required!</u>

<u>Check-in:</u> Two adults, one whom is over 21, must be present in order to check-in. Groups should arrive together and check-in at the designated time.

Mary Ann Beebe: Motorized entry gates now require a code, you will receive the code during your reservation confirmation phone call with the Ranger. All vehicles are to be parked at main parking lot. It is your responsibility to give the code to all your group drivers so they can enter the camp.

Troop Roster: You will need to give the Ranger/Site Monitor a **completed** Troop Roster/Signed Agreement **(found on the last page of this packet)** upon arrival. The roster list needs to include name, phone and age of anyone spending the night. You will not be let into your site (s) until this is turned in.

General Information

- \cdot No running on any camp property
- · Notify the Ranger/Site Monitor if anything is missing from units.
- Adult supervision is required near ponds and streams at all times. *During winter months, please stay off the ice.*
- Review emergency procedures and exits with your entire group at your campsite.
- At outdoor facilities fire buckets should be filled on arrival and emptied on departure.
- Groups are responsible for providing all first aid, emergency care, and emergency transportations. There are emergency evacuation plans and maps posted at each site.
- Recycling: separate recyclable items and place in recycling containers. Other garbage needs to be placed in the garbage cans.
- **DO NOT** approach wild animals. Notify the ranger/site monitor of the presence of any nuisance animals.
- Do not pick flowers, break branches from trees or bushes, or dig holes in the ground.
- Do not remove furnishings or equipment from any of the lodges. Outdoor units should have the equipment you need for outdoor cooking. Contact the ranger if items are missing.

Restricted Areas

• The Ranger's house and yard are considered a private residence and are not available for camper use. If assistance is needed for an emergency, please contact the Ranger on call with the phone number posted at each site.

<u>Girl Scout Activities requiring a trained facilitator (s)</u>

- Prior arrangements and activity fees need to be paid before entering an activity requiring a trained facilitator.
- Facilitator Requests are not guaranteed at time of booking, and you are simply making a request. Requests for facilitators are made with GSNI staff and will be confirmed as soon as possible.
