Let's have the best year ever!

The Juliette Star guidelines provide you (Juliette Girl Scout and adult Juliette Caregiver) with a roadmap for your Girl Scout year. Following this roadmap will lead to an exceptional experience and set you up for success. Or, in other words, you'll have the best year ever! To qualify for Juliette Star designation, you must complete 10 required elements and 3 your choice elements (because Girl Scouts is all about customizing your experience).

There are just a few things you might want to know first...



Timing

The Juliette Star Program spans the membership year.
(October 1 through September 30)

Patches

All Juliette Girl Scouts and adult Juliette Caregivers earning Juliette Star for the first time receive the Juliette Star patch. After the first year, Juliettes and adults will receive the year bar.

Patches are received once completed Juliette Star Packets are submitted. This program is “on your honor” which means you are immediately eligible to receive the patches.

This is a GSNI program, and patches/bars should be worn on the back of the tunic, vest, or sash.



Forms

Completed forms may be submitted between June 15 and October 15 each year. When you're all finished, you have two options for submitting your packet and receiving your patches.

Option 1: Visit a Resource Center

Visit any GSNI Resource Center to submit your completed packet and receive the appropriate patches and/or year bars.

Option 2: Via Email

Email the completed Juliette Star Packet to customercare@girlscoutsni.org with SUBJECT LINE: Juliette Star. Once your email is received, you will be contacted with pick-up instructions or to gather payment information for the shipping fees.

Adult Assistance

Required Elements: Complete all 3!

Adult Registration:

Adult must register to participate alongside their youth and register as a Juliette Caregiver.

Adult Training:

Juliette Caregiver should complete any assigned training in gsLearn.

Safety Activity Checkpoints (SAC):

Juliette Caregiver has made use of Safety Activity Checkpoints and discussed safety and emergency rules with their Juliette Girl Scout for activities, field trips, and overnights.

NOTE: Safety Activity Checkpoints are found on GSNI's website.

Adult Assistance

Your Choice Elements: Complete at least 1!

Service Unit Meetings:

Juliette Caregiver has attended at least 3 service unit meetings during the membership year.

Early Renewal:

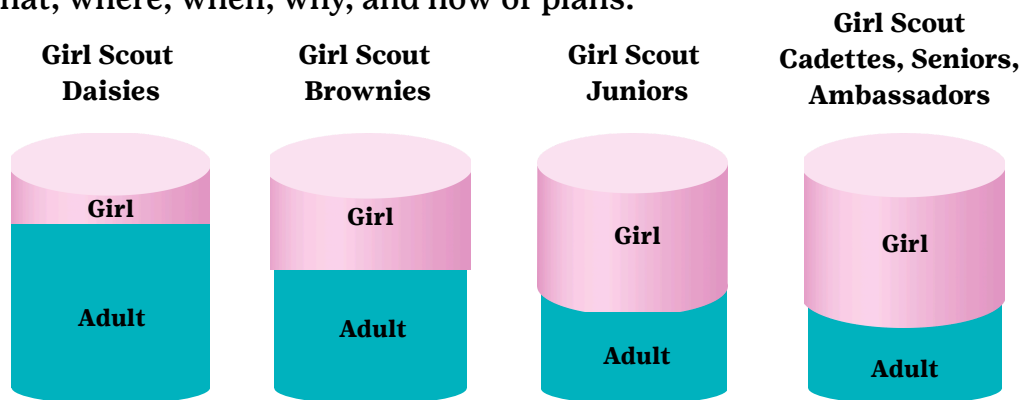
Juliette Girl Scout and Juliette Caregiver have renewed for the next membership year by June 30.

Girl Scout Ways & Traditions

Required Elements: Complete all 5!

Promise & Law: Juliette Girl Scout is able to understand the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

Girl-Led: Juliette Girl Scout took an active and grade-appropriate role in figuring out the what, where, when, why, and how of plans.



Community Service/Take Action:
Juliette Girl Scout participated in at least one community service and/or Take Action! project.

NOTE: It is recommended service projects be those where youth members are physically doing or making something for someone in the community. Girl Scouts may NOT raise money for other groups which includes activities such as ringing bells for the The Salvation Army. Service projects may include participation in one of the Girl Scout National Service Projects.

Fall Product Program:
Juliette Girl Scout participated in the Fall Product Program and (if returning) earned more Cashew Cash than the prior year.

Juliette Girl Scout earned the current year's World Thinking Day Award.
