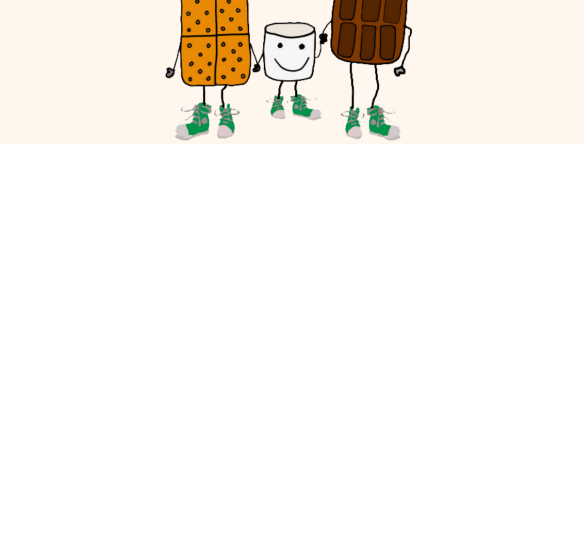

Complete and turn in the 2024 Troop Financial Report

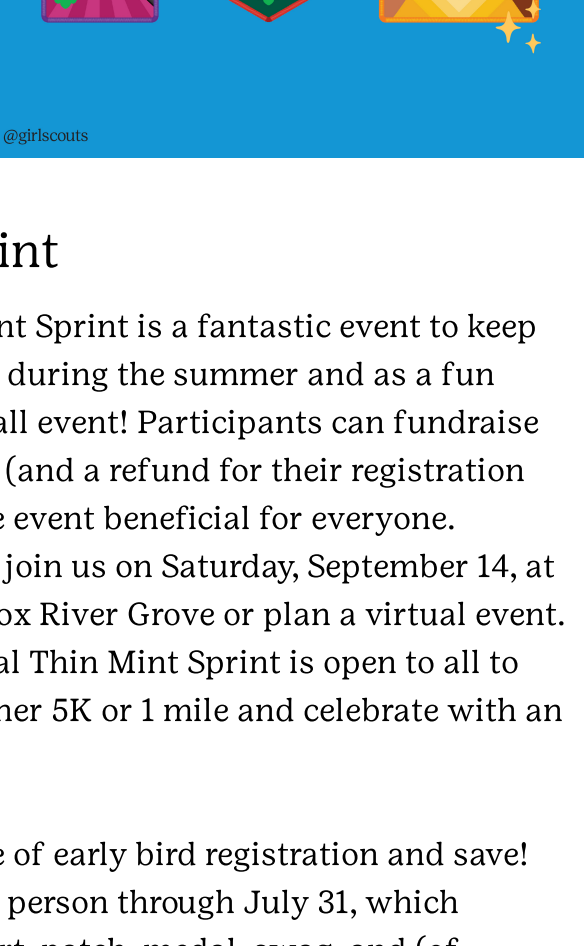

Volunteer Led Camp Committees Thank You

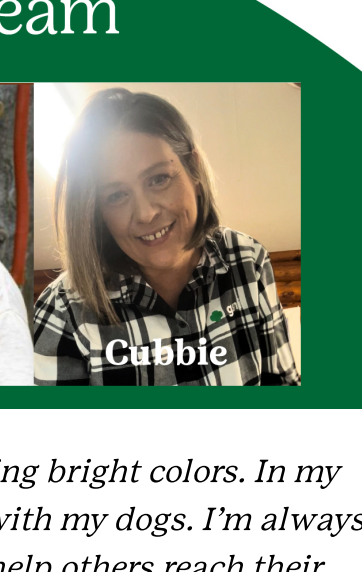

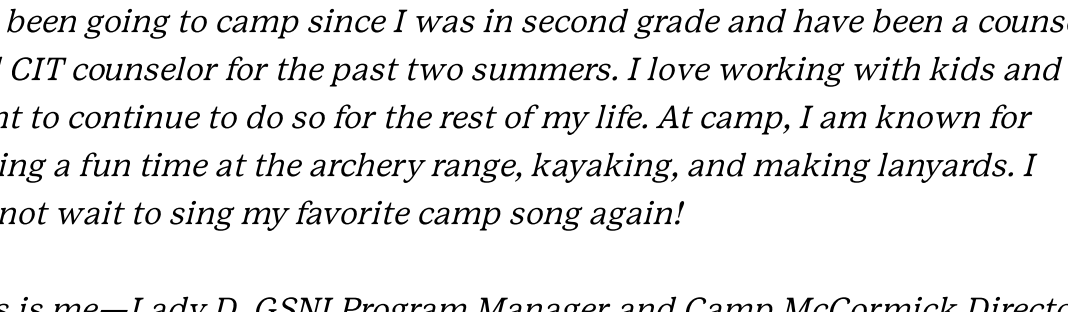
