



Chaperone Agreement for Troop Trip Travel

I understand that as a trip chaperone I play an essential role in the success of the trip and that my attitudes, behavior, and responsibilities as a role model are critical to the success of the endeavor.

Therefore, I agree to do the following:

- Be sensitive to the needs of each participant.
- Respect the places and people with whom I come in contact.
- Understand that I will be responsible for other participants other than my child.
- Review and become familiar with all materials/forms/travel requirements and interpret them to girls and their families.
- Ensure that Girl Scout safety standards and council policies/procedures are followed during all phases of the project.
- Participate in opportunities for youth participants to develop necessary skills and participate in team-building activities.
- Be responsible for the safety and well-being of ALL participants during travel which may include caring for a child who becomes ill during travel and unable to participate in travel plans.
- Participate in trip evaluation.
- Be responsible for my personal belongings.
- Share my experience with Girl Scouts throughout Girl Scouts of Northern Illinois.

I also understand that:

- The use or possession of alcohol, firearms, or illegal drugs by adults and youth participants will not be tolerated, and usage during the trip may result in expulsion from the trip.
- I will not smoke in the vicinity of any minors on the trip.
- I understand the use of tobacco by the minors is not allowed.
- If I am dismissed due to any serious misconduct, it will be at my personal expense.
