

Girl Scout Organizer

This position description is a guide to utilize as an aid for what best fits your service unit. GSNI understands service units differ and trust your team will customize these responsibilities to best serve your members.

Girl Scout Organizers are the Girl Scout spirit squad! They are the unstoppable force that connects their school spirit to their love of Girl Scouts. They help new and existing members at their school navigate the Girl Scout community and help keep Girl Scouts visible in both their school and community. The Girl Scout Organizers are supported by the Service Unit Team.

The Girl Scout Organizer assists the service unit by:

- ◆ *Connecting with the school community (administration, teachers, and caregivers)*
 - Be available to answer questions, provide resources, and connect the school community with the Service Unit Team.
 - Foster a social network of the troop within their school.
 - Share your Girl Scout experiences with families interested in joining.
- ◆ *Supporting the Registrar and Service Unit Team with recruiting and retaining members*
 - Ensure Girl Scouts has a presence at every possible event.
 - Attend school events or find another volunteer to attend.
 - Assist at family information nights planned by the Service Unit Team.
 - Pass along any community events where Girl Scouts could host a table.
- ◆ *Following the Girl Scout Promise and Law*

The Girl Scout Organizer position is essential to the continued success of the service unit and GSNI. We would like you to fill the position for a minimum of one year, but we hope to have you part of the team for longer. At any time, a volunteer may be appointed to another Girl Scout position, removed from a position, or may resign.
