The Service Unit Team and Membership Engagement Specialist (MES) support the Recognition Chair.

Recognition Chairs assist the service unit by:

- ◆ *Acknowledging volunteers' dedication to their troops and Girl Scouts*
 - Plan an appreciation event for volunteers in the spring.
 - Sprinkle gratitude throughout the year.
- ◆ *Supporting GSNI's Volunteer Recognition Awards*
 - Encourage members to submit nominations for volunteers.
 - Submit nominations.
 - Consider joining GSNI's Recognition Committee.
- ◆ *Arranging recognition opportunities for Girl Scouts*
 - Organize a bridging ceremony.
 - Plan an event for Girl Scouts to present their Highest Awards.
- ◆ *Following the Girl Scout Promise and Law*
