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The Cookie Program isn't over yet! While the Initial Order is complete, the program runs until **March 22**, giving your Girl Scout plenty of time to reach her goals—and beyond! There are many ways to continue participating:

- **[Cookie Booths](#)**: Set up booths at local spots to connect with customers.
- **[Digital Cookie](#)**: Keep sharing your Girl Scout's personalized link to reach more buyers online.
- **[Cookie Cravers](#)**: Use the Cookie Craver order card to collect additional orders.
- **Walkabouts**: Walk through the neighborhood with cookies on hand—customers love the convenience of buying cookies on the spot and seeing Girl Scouts out and about.
- **[Cookie Business Challenge](#)**: The Cookie Business Challenge gives Girl Scouts the opportunity to build confidence and real-world business skills by connecting with and recognizing local businesses that support the Girl Scout Cookie Program. By completing the challenge [form](#) by the deadline, Girl Scouts earn a special patch while helping highlight community partners who make cookie season possible.

With these opportunities, your Girl Scout can keep the momentum going while spreading joy (and cookies!) in the community.

Troops will be receiving their Initial Order delivery over the next few weeks, then sorting and distributing to Girl Scouts in the troop. Once these are received, **please work with your Girl Scout to sort and distribute to customers in a timely manner.** Remember to include a thank you note, and consider adding your Girl Scout's [QR code](#) so customers can place a refill order!

Keep in communication with your Troop Cookie Chair/Leader for any new Digital Cookie girl delivery orders received and approved. Packages for these orders must be received from the troop inventory and the troop may need to get additional cookies from a cookie cupboard to fulfill orders.

Parents do have the option to turn off delivery in Digital Cookie. While we encourage Girl Scouts to use all available selling methods, families may choose what works best for them.
