Council Booth first round sign-up through eBudde begins at 6 a.m. on Wednesday, January 21, through Sunday, January 25 (11:59pm). During this time, troops may sign-up for a maximum of three booths at three different retailers. Requests for approval for Troop Booths (booths reserved by the troop) can be entered now into eBudde.
