## Activities

Girl Scouts may participate in a variety of activities offered through the 2026 GSNI Cookie Program. Details on all activities can be found at [www.girlscoutsni.org/cookieresources](http://www.girlscoutsni.org/cookieresources) and [Rallyhood](#).

- **Cookie Craver**—Girl Scouts collect orders; parents complete forms and picks up cookies from a participating cupboard. Girl Scouts earn a Goal Getter patch for 18+ packages sold through this activity.
- **Cookie Business Challenge**—Girl Scouts visit or contact businesses and ask them to purchase or donate a case or more of cookies. Sell to 3+ businesses and earn a patch. Businesses are rewarded too!

## Digital Cookie

Digital Cookie allows Girl Scouts to create a customized website, send emails to customers and to take online orders for cookies. Customers order and pay for cookies online and then have the option for the cookies to be shipped directly to them (shipping charges apply) or have the Girl Scout deliver the cookies or donate cookies with no additional fees.



Digital Cookie invite emails will be sent to parents from Girl Scout Cookie Program ([email@girlscouts.org](mailto:email@girlscouts.org)) Friday, January 2, with the subject “It’s time to register your Girl Scout for Digital Cookie!”. Once a Girl Scout’s account is set up go to the [Digital Cookie Mobile App](#) can be used as a convenient sales tool!

## Rewards

## Sister Sales Team Rewards

Two or more Girl Scouts in the same family must be participating in the GSNI 2026 Cookie Program. Girl Scouts must live in the same household (full or part-time). To qualify for the rewards, the [online Sister Reward form](#) must be completed by *Friday, March 27*. Sister Girl Scouts can earn three rewards together! Review [Sister Rewards](#) for more details.



**Sister Patch**—Two Girl Scouts in the family must sell a combined total of 300 packages.

**Cookie All-Stars event**—Two Girl Scouts in the family must sell a combined total of 1,000 packages.

**Color Dash Bash event**—Two Girl Scouts in the family must sell a combined total of 1,200 packages.

## Adhere to GSNI Cookie Program dates, pricing, council boundaries, and cookies.

Program dates and pricing are specific for each Girl Scout council. It is important that Girl Scouts and families follow the program dates and pricing for GSNI. Girl Scouts may participate January 6-March 22. Cookie Booth can be held February 13-March 22. All GSNI troops must keep in-person sales, including cookie booths and door-to-door sales, within the boundaries of GSNI. Finally, only cookies from Little Brownie Bakers may be sold by GSNI Girl Scouts.
