

# 2026 Girl Scout Cookie Program Reward Descriptions



The Girl Scout's order card pictures the individual rewards Girl Scouts can earn by reaching different levels of packages sold. Below we have highlighted new rewards and additional details on higher level rewards unable to explain in the minimal space on the order card.

Reminder, the changes to rewards were based on Girl Scout feedback, especially asking for new and more experiences, events, and wearables. We will continue to survey Girl Scouts every year .....

## **NEW** Initial Order Reward—Girl Scout Life t-shirt

150+ packages earned during Initial Order (by January 26, 2026)

- Troop Cookie Chair/leader must enter Girl Scout t-shirt size when submitting Initial Order rewards in eBudde by deadline of Tuesday, January 27, at 11:59 p.m.
- Shirts will be available within approximately 3 weeks after Initial Order.

## 600-799 packages—CHOICE

1. Cookie All-Stars at Main Event, Hoffman Estates
  - a. Saturday, June 6, 2026, at 10 a.m. -2 p.m.
  - b. Girl Scouts will earning and choosing the reward event will be invited with a chaperone.
  - c. Activities for Girl Scouts include Bowling, Laser Tag, Gravity Ropes Course with Zipline, Billiards, and Shuffleboard, plus, a \$10 Arcade Card (with prizing).
  - d. Pizza and drinks will be available for both Girl Scout and chaperone.
  - e. Venue will be open to public during time of the event, but a private room used for food and other opportunities.
  - f. Other family members may attend to participate in activities, not including food and drink in the private room, at their own expense. These costs will be sent with the invitation.
  - g. The GSNI Mobile store will be available in the parking lot in front of the facility.
2. Create your own Hoodie and Hat at South Elgin Creation Station, South Elgin Resource Center
  - a. Girl Scouts earning and choosing the reward will attend [Creation Station](#) at South Elgin or Rockford Resource Centers during the dates below. Times will be scheduled after the program ends when we know how many Girl Scouts earned and chose the reward
    - i. South Elgin—April 11 & 12 and 18 & 19
    - ii. Rockford—May 9 & 10 and 16 & 17
  - b. Hoodie with one large decal and either GSNI logo or Trefoil. Hat with 3 patches, 2 pins/buttons, and 1 chain.

## 800-999 packages—CHOICE

1. BFF Blanket and Shoe that Grows
  - a. The blanket will be received with troop reward distribution. The Show that Grows patch, to represent their donation, will be mailed directly to Girl Scouts by June.
2. Color Dash Bash at Camp McCormick
  - a. Saturday, May 2, 2026
  - b. Time of event will be determined based on number of Girl Scouts earning and if multiple shifts are needed. Length of the event we anticipate being approximately 2 hours, but we will update as we continue finalizing event plans.
  - c. Girl Scouts will create a tie-dye shirt and participate in an obstacle course throughout Camp McCormick.
    - i. This is a color fun, messy obstacle course with options for all ages. Color powder and other colored activities will be part of the course.
    - ii. This is not a race.
  - d. More details to come.

Rewards at 1,000+ packages are non-cumulative, meaning only the highest reward level reached will be earned.

1,000-1,499 packages—CHOICE

1. Build-A-Bear Workshop at South Elgin Resource Center
  - a. Saturday, May 4, times will be determined after the program when we know how many Girl Scouts earned and chose the reward.
  - b. Reward includes a furry friend with a Girl Scout vest/tunic or shirt, snacks, and other activities for the Girl Scout. Chaperone attends with the Girl Scout.
  - c. Girl Scouts will choose their furry friend and vest/tunic or shirt in advance with event invitations are sent. At the event, Girl Scouts may purchase additional accessories. Due to time constraints, we ask that no other furry friends are purchased during the event.
  - d. The GSNI Resource Center store will be open during the event.
2. Kendra Scott Color Bar Experience
  - a. Girl Scouts create their own jewelry by choosing
    - i. Style of jewelry—necklace, bracelet, earrings
    - ii. Metal color—gold or silver
    - iii. Color and shape of stone
  - b. Girl Scouts will go to the Kendra Scott store in Naperville (55 S. Main Street, Space 111) to make their selections in person during set time frame
  - c. Finished jewelry will be picked up from a GSNI Resource Center.
  - d. If the Girl Scout is unable to travel to Naperville, there will be an option to complete a form to make the selections.

1,500-1,999 packages—CHOICE

1. Safari Adventure & Pizza Night, Lake Geneva
  - a. Girl Scout and a chaperone will receive tickets to [Safari Lake Geneva](#), a drive through safari adventure and a gift card to [Next Door Pub & Pizzeria](#).
  - b. Date is chosen by Girl Scout/parent, but must be confirmed in advance to purchase tickets.
2. Beats Studio 3 headphones
  - a. Headphones will be shipped directly to the Girl Scout following the program.

2,000-3,499 packages—CHOICE

1. Build Your Own Camping Kit
  - a. Girl Scouts will receive an Amazon code to select and order from a pre-determined list with a wide variety of camping equipment choices to complete her own camping kit.
  - b. Items will be shipped directly to the Girl Scout.
2. Six Flags Great America Gold Season passes
  - a. Girl Scout and chaperone will each receive a 2026 Gold Pass which includes access to Six Flags Great America, Hurricane Harbor Chicago & Rockford, plus free parking, in-park discounts and more for the entire 2026 season.
  - b. Once received, the ticket must be activated at Six Flags Great America.

3,500+ packages—Choose Your Adventure!

1. Louisville Zoo Adopt a Black-Footed Ferret and 4-night trip to Louisville, KY
  - a. Girl Scout adopts a Black-Footed Ferret from the [Louisville Zoo](#). With that adoption she receives
    - i. Adoption certificate and fact sheet
    - ii. Featured on website for a year
    - iii. Zoo magnet
    - iv. Plush animal toy
    - v. 2 admission passes to the Zoo
  - b. Girl Scout and a chaperone also receive
    - i. 4-night hotel accommodations
    - ii. General Admission tickets to [Kentucky Kingdom Theme and Water Park](#)

- iii. Gift Certificate for dinner at [Mark's Feed Store](#)
  - c. Dates of travel selected by the Girl Scout/chaperone. Must be completed booked by September 15, 2026.
  - d. Transportation not included.
- 2. Great Wolf Lodge with Wolf Pass for Girl Scout 4-night stay
  - a. Girl Scout and chaperone receive 4-night stay (standard room) at a [Great Wolf Lodge](#) location of your choice. Stay includes
    - i. Water Park access
    - ii. Attractions (varies by location)
    - iii. Activities and Entertainment (varies by location)
  - b. Girl Scout receives a Wolf Pass (included items vary by location)
  - c. Dates of travel selected by the Girl Scout/chaperone. Must be completed booked by September 15, 2026.
  - d. Transportation not included.

Both adventures also include

  - a. Girl Scout chooses color and size of Classic Crocs.
- 2. Stanley Cup
  - a. Girl Scouts will receive an Amazon code to select and order from a pre-determined list with Stanley Cups and accessories.

\$25 Cookie Dough will only be rewarded at the 500+ package level with an expiration date of September 15, 2026.

#### Top 25 Girl Scout Entrepreneur reward

**NEW** By request, GSNI will be offering a Cookie Hustle Club sweatshirt (choice of crewneck or hoodie) for the Top 25 Entrepreneurs. Girl Scouts earning will be contacted after the end of the program. Girl Scout whose troop opt-outs of rewards will still be eligible for this reward.



#### CEO Party

**NEW** the Top 10 Girl Scout Entrepreneurs will be invited to a party with Jodi Dahlke, CEO. [Vote](#) by Monday, January 19, for the activity to be planned with Jodi! Date, time, and activity of CEO Party to be determined.

#### Troop Membership Reward

Troops reach a final PGA (per Girl Scout average of Girl Scouts selling) of 400+ packages. \$40 off membership renewal for 2026/2027 Girl Scout membership year for all Girl Scouts in the troop that participated in the 2026 Cookie Program.

### Opt-Out of Rewards

Girl Scout troops at Cadette, Senior, and Ambassador levels have the option to opt-out of rewards and the troop will receive an additional 10¢ per package in troop proceeds. For troops choosing to opt-out of rewards, Girl Scouts will **not** receive an invitation to reward events including Cookie All-Stars, Color Dash Bash, and Build-A-Bear and troop **does not** receive the Troop Membership Reward. A multi-level troop which includes Girl Scouts at the Daisy, Brownie, or Junior levels may not opt-out of rewards.
