Cookie Program Participation Methods

Girl Scouts must have parent permission before participating in the Cookie Program.

- **Digital Cookie**—Digital Cookie link/URL can be used in combination with any participation methods.
- **Door-to-Door**—Take cookie orders using the cookie order card or Digital Cookie Mobile App.
- **By Phone**—Call or text customers personally.
- **Social Media**—Post messages on approved social media sites following all social media policies.
- **Email**—Send emails to customers through Digital Cookie or adding Digital Cookie URL to own email.
- **Cookie Craver**—After Initial Order, use order card and pick-up cookies from Council Cupboard.
- **Walk-about**—After troop receives cookies, go door-to-door with cookies in-hand.
- **Cookie Booth**—Sign-up or arrange for one or more cookie booth sites.
- Cookie Stand—Hold a "lemonade stand" style booth as a Girl Scout's house.
- **Gift of Caring**—Promote purchase of cookies for donation.
- **Parent Workplace**—Design flyers to post with an order card or Digital Cookie QR code at the workplace or go to the workplace to take orders in-person. Please follow all workplace policies.
- **Businesses**—Contact business owners to make a cookie purchase. See Cookie Business Challenge.

Activities

Girl Scouts may participate in a variety of activities offered through the 2024 GSNI Cookie Program. Details on all activities can be found at www.girlscoutsni.org/cookieresources and Rallyhood.

- **Cookie Craver**—Girl Scouts collect orders; parents complete forms and pick-up cookies from a council cupboard. Participants earn Goal Getter patch for 18+ packages sold through this activity.
- **Cookie Business Challenge**—Girl Scouts visit or contact businesses and ask them to purchase or donate a case or more cookies. Sell to 3+ businesses and earn a patch. Businesses are rewarded too!

Digital Cookie

Digital Cookie allows Girl Scouts to create a customized website, send emails to customers and to take online orders for cookies. Customers order and pay for cookies online and then have the option for the cookies to be shipped directly to them (shipping charges apply) or have the Girl Scout deliver the cookies or donate cookies with no additional fees.

- **NEW** Girl Scouts/Parents enter Initial Order into Digital Cookie and transfers to eBudde™.
- OCR card scanning and QR code available with Digital Cookie Mobile App.
- Digital Cookie Mobile App sales tool. Girl Scouts must be registered in Digital Cookie to use mobile app.

Digital Cookie registration/login information will be sent in an email to parents from Girl Scout Cookie Program (email@email.girlscouts.org) Wednesday, January 3, with the subject "Register for the Digital Cookie Platform today". Once a Girl Scout's account is set up go to https://digitalcookie.girlscouts.org/login.

Rewards

Cookie Dough earned will be awarded via e-code and sent by email to the parent email listed with the Girl Scout's membership. Only the highest Cookie Dough earned is awarded. Rewards at the 1050 pkg. level and above will be distributed at Seller-bration events or individually.



Sister Sales Team patch

• Two Girl Scouts in the same family have a unique opportunity to earn a

"Sister Sales Team" patch by selling a total of



300 packages of cookies (one Girl Scout must sell a minimum of 135 packages).

- Other Multiple-Girl Scout Family special rewards available at 500 package and 3500 package levels.

Adhere to GSNI Cookie Program dates, pricing, council boundaries, and cookies.

Program dates and pricing are specific for each Girl Scout council. It is important that Girl Scouts and families follow the program dates and pricing for GSNI. Girl Scouts may participate January 5-March 10. Cookie Booth can be held February 9-March 10. All GSNI troops must keep in-person sales, including cookie booths and door-to-door sales, within the boundaries of GSNI. Finally, only cookies from Little Brownie Bakers may be sold by GSNI Girl Scouts.
