Most of the people you sell Girl Scout Cookies to either have a dog in their family, or have a special dog in their life. Dogs are part of the family, just like sisters, brothers, cousins, parents, and grandparents. Our families get to enjoy Girl Scout Cookies every year, we want to help the family dogs enjoy this program too!

Patch Pals™ are only available online, so consumers can buy them easily from your Digital Cookie store for it to be shipped to their home.

Most dog parents enjoy stocking up on dog snacks online, so here are ways to reach this new audience.





Patch Pals™ were created with BARK, the company behind BarkBox, which is obsessed with making dogs happy.

DOGS WHO WOULD LOVE PATCH PALS

TYPE: Whole Group | No materials needed | 5 minutes

HOW TO PLAY:

Ask girls to stand up if their answer is yes and yell their answer.

- “Do you have a dog?”
- “Do your friends have a dog?”
- “Do your relatives have a dog?”
- “Do your neighbors have a dog?”
- “Do you know a dog who deserves a treat?”

By the end, almost everyone is standing.
That’s your customer list!

Next, ask each girl to raise their hand if they think they might find dog people at:

A pet store?

A dog park?

In their neighborhood?

Even online, like who they sell to in the fall program?

This is how you can find your dog people!

LEADER TIP: Use this to lead into the product introduction.





NEXT: ACT LIKE A DOG

HOW TO PLAY:

Leader calls out actions: Fetch! Roll Over! Sit!

Each girl acts like a dog doing a trick or command.

Sit, shake, roll over, spin, do a biiiig stretch like a dog that just woke up from a nap.

Girls act them out at the same time. Create your own pack!

LEADER TIP: Ask for volunteers first.

Once a few girls go, everyone will want to join in.

STATION 1

Patch Pals Facts

GOAL: Learn the facts about **Patch Pals™** so you can answer customer questions with confidence.

SUPPLIES: Printed question cards | One leader per station

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Leader reads a question out loud.
2. Girls take turns answering.
3. If no one knows, the leader shares the answer.
4. Play until all questions are answered.

Leader tip: The next page can be printed for girls to take home with them so they can reference these whenever they'd like.



SAMPLE QUESTIONS (Print this card if you can)

Are these safe for dogs? (Yes, they are made just for dogs!)

Why should someone buy this? (So their dog can be part of cookie season too)

What if a dog has allergies? (Patch Pals are made with ingredients very few dogs are allergic to)

What are Patch Pals made with? (Blueberries)

Where are Patch Pals sold? (Online only)

How big does a dog need to be? (At least 5 lbs)

How old does a dog need to be? (At least 6 months old)

Where are they made? (Right here in the USA!)

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STATION 2

Booth Marketing

GOAL: Learn how to tell customers about **Patch Pals™** at your booth through fun visuals.

SUPPLIES: Printed script cards
Optional: pretend cookies as props

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. One girl plays the customer. One girl plays the seller.
2. The seller uses the script card to talk about **Patch Pals™**.
3. Switch roles and try again!

SAMPLE PITCH:

“We have a new treat this year—just for dogs! It’s called **Patch Pals™**. They’re soft baked dog cookies made with blueberries. You can order them online Do you have a dog at home?”



LEADER TIP:

Remind girls that **Patch Pals™** are online only. Customers can’t buy them at the booth—but they can scan a QR code or write down the link!

STATION 3

Digital Marketing

GOAL: Learn how to share **Patch Pals™** online and get more customers.

SUPPLIES: Paper and markers | QR code card (one per girl)
Optional: device to scan QR code

FOCUS: Sharing with family & friends

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Give each girl their Digital Cookie QR code card (available in the Digital Cookie App)
2. Girls design a pretend social media post on paper — draw the post, write the caption, add emoji!
3. If devices are available: scan the QR code at the bottom of this page to visit the **Patch Pals™** sticker generator. Girls can upload a photo of their dog (or a dog in their life) to get a fun cartoon illustration!

SAMPLE CAPTIONS:

- “Your dog deserves a treat too! Get **Patch Pals™** online now.”
- “Cookie season just got even better. Now there’s a Girl Scout Cookie for dogs, too!”

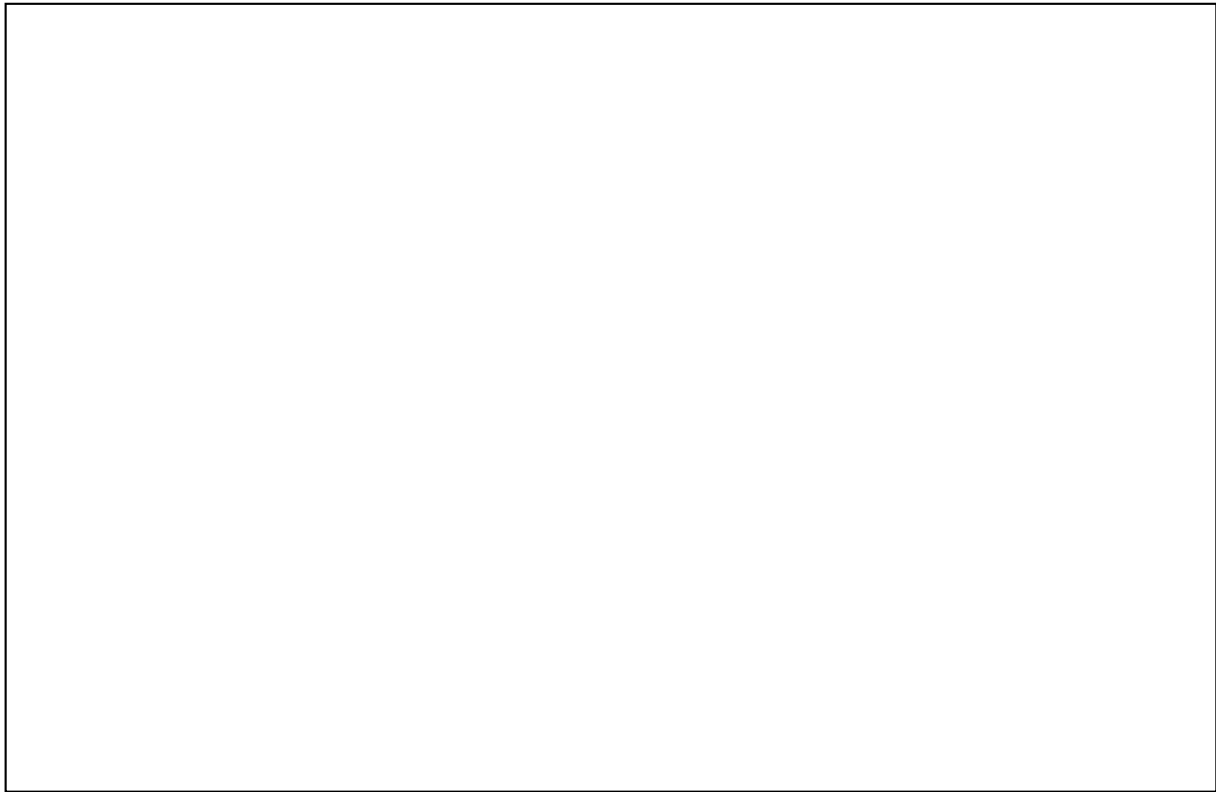
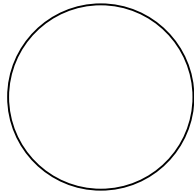
LEADER TIP: Remind girls to always get a grown-up’s help before posting anything online.

INSTRUCTIONS:

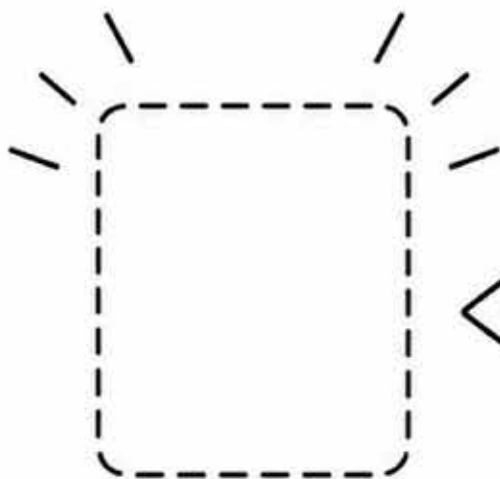
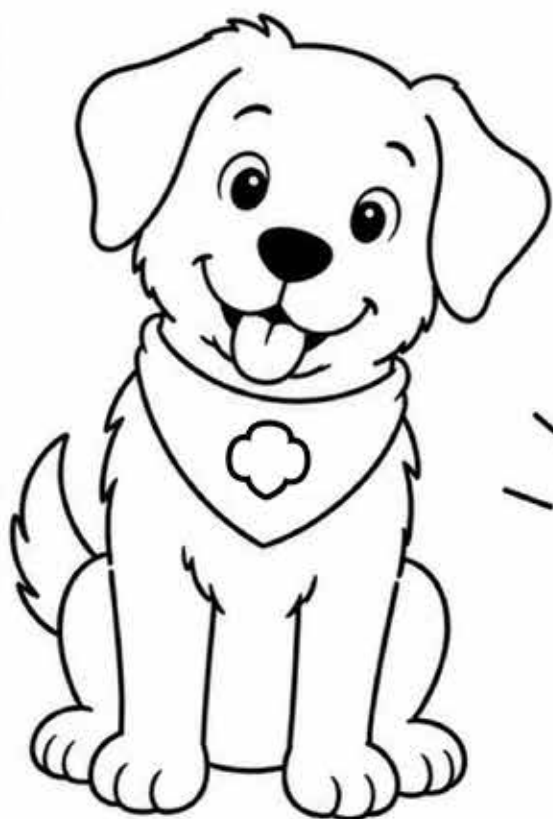
1. Each girl (or small group) designs a booth sign for **Patch Pals**

STATION 6

Community Connection

GOAL: Discover how to be a sister to every dog in your neighborhood and learn about the badges you can earn while doing it.

FOCUS: Caring for animals in our community

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Brainstorm: As a group, list three ways you can help dogs in your own neighborhood (e.g., offer to walk an elderly neighbor's dog, make a "Lost Dog" flyer template, or learn how to safely approach a new pet).
2. Talk about one "Action Step" you'd like to take this month to help a local animal.
3. Badge Discovery: Look at the badge requirements below. How can selling **Patch Pals™** help you start earning these badges?

BADGE CONNECTIONS:

Daisies: "Responsible for what I say and do" petal. How can you be a responsible dog advocate?

Brownies: Pets Badge. Learn what pets need to stay healthy and happy.

Juniors: Animal Habitats Badge. Discover where wild dogs live and how to protect their homes.

SERVICE IDEAS:

- Visit a shelter: Call a local rescue to find out what items they need most (blankets, towels, or toys).
- Help a neighbor: With a grown-up's help, offer to play with a neighbor's dog in their yard if they are busy or tired.
- Education: Create a "Dog Body Language" poster to show friends when a dog is happy or needs space.

LEADER TIP: This station is about building compassion and responsibility. While **Patch Pals™** is a great conversation starter, remind the girls that being a Girl Scout means taking action to make the world a better place for all creatures!

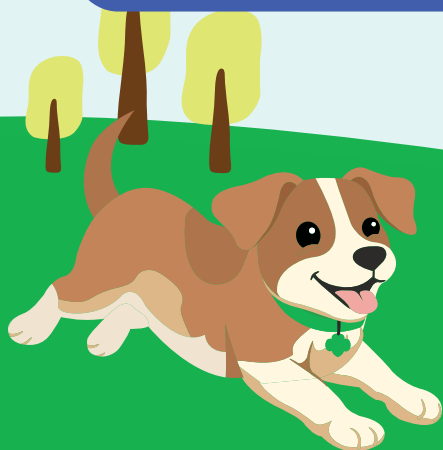

Frozen Pup Treat

A frozen treat your dog will love — and you can make it at home!

WHAT YOU NEED:

- 1 cup plain yogurt (no sugar added)
- 1/2 cup blueberries
- 1 tablespoon honey
- Ice cube tray or paper cups

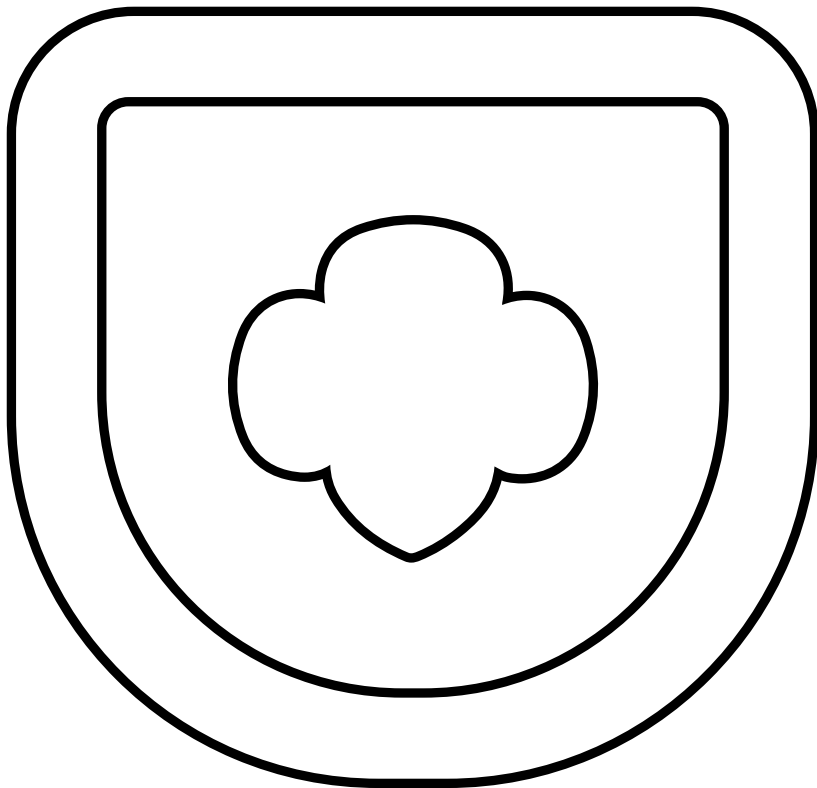
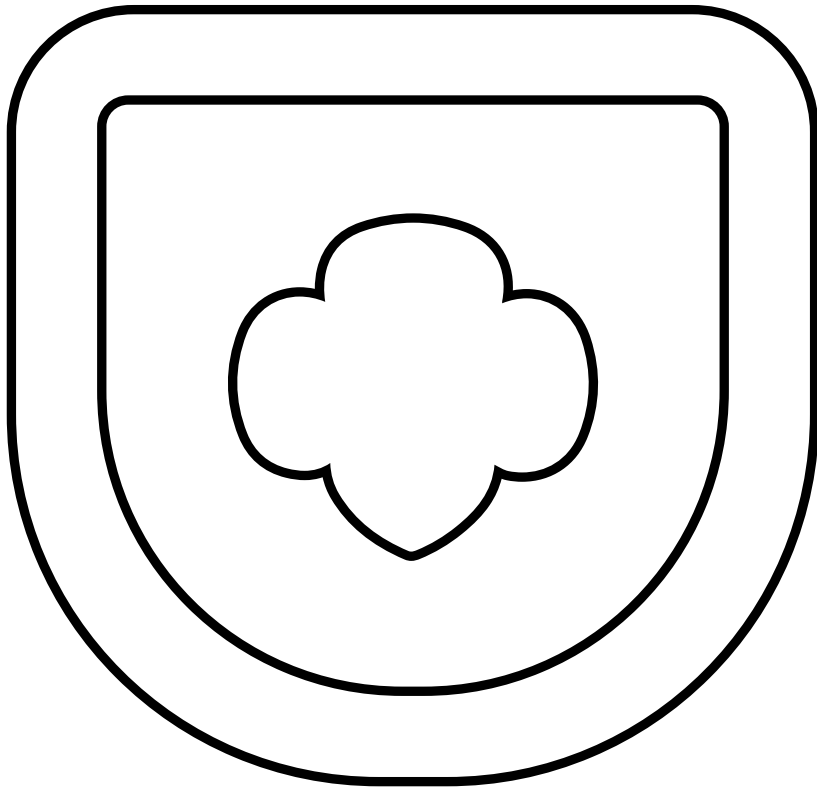
HOW TO MAKE IT:

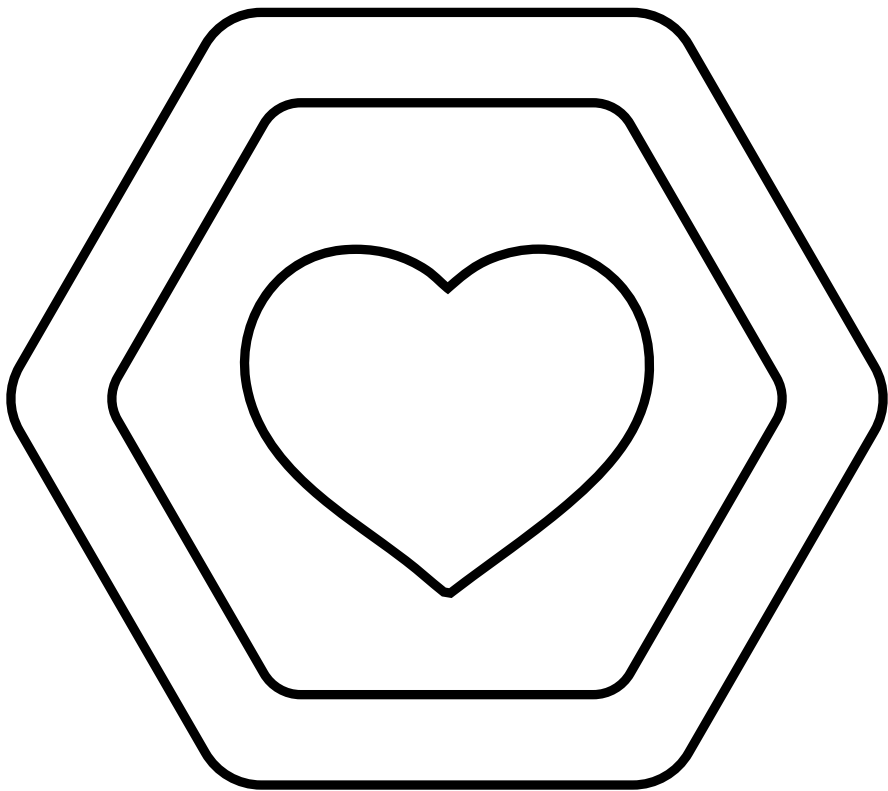
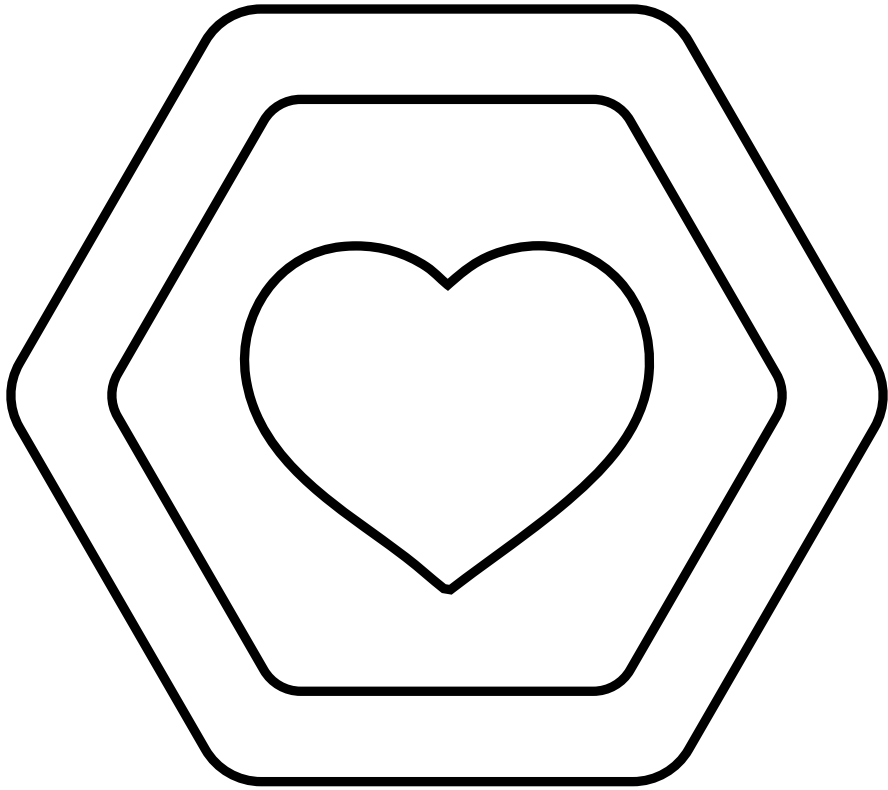
1. Mix the yogurt, blueberries, and honey together in a bowl.
2. Pour the mix into your ice cube tray or paper cups.
3. Freeze for at least 4 hours.
4. Pop them out and give one to your dog!

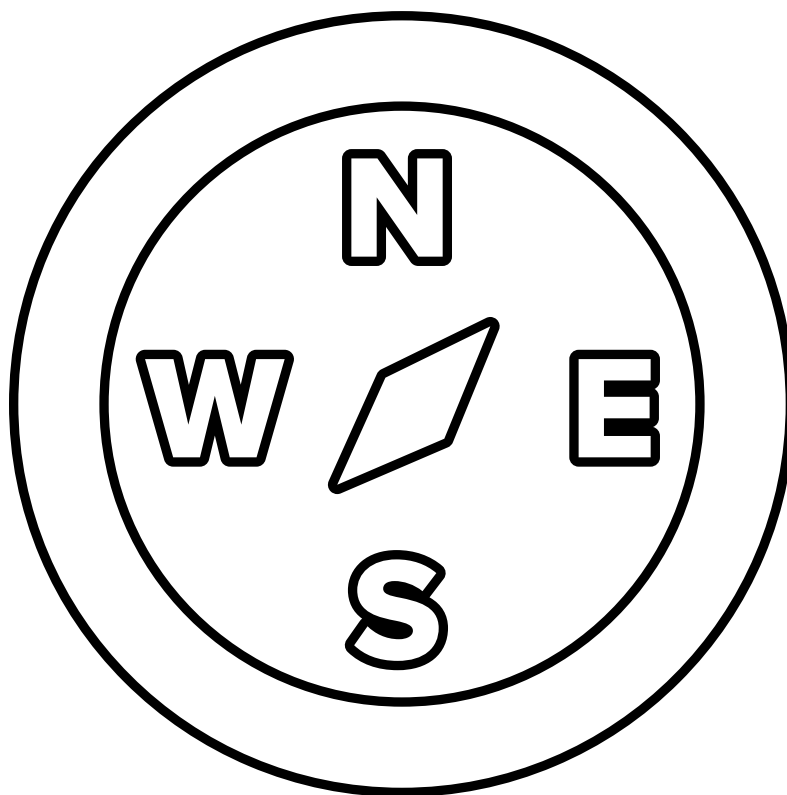
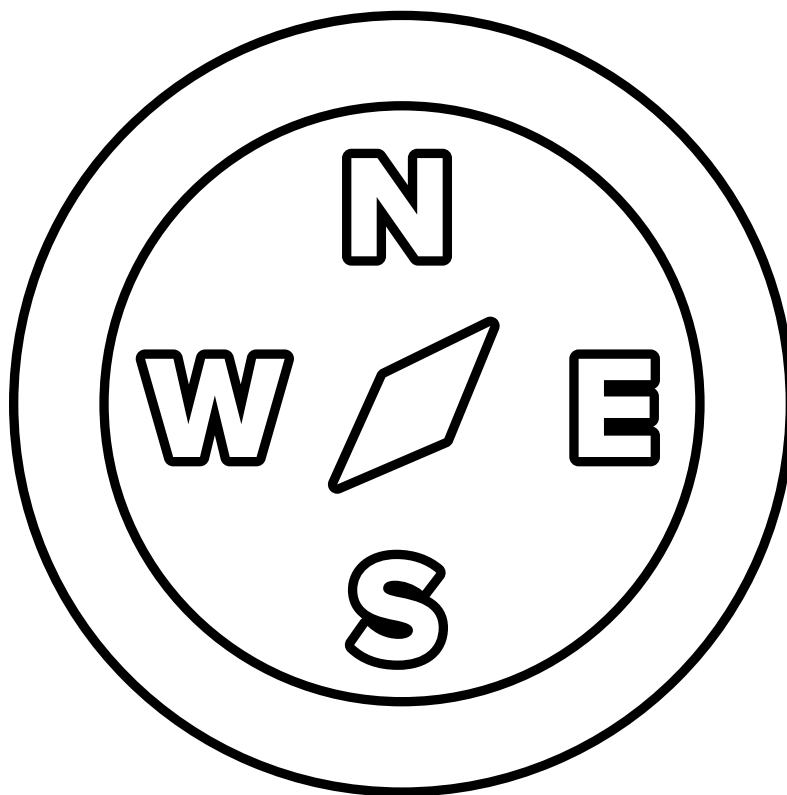
